Position Qualifications:

- Bachelor’s Degree in Civil Engineering or related field required
- Professional Engineering certification desired
- Five (5) years civil engineering experience required; open channel flow experience desired
- Three (3) years drafting software experience required; three (3) years GIS experience preferred
- All positions within the District require a valid Washington State driver license with insurable MVR (Motor Vehicle Record), successful completion of pre-employment drug test and extensive background investigation
- Must perform night and weekend duty during the water season (approx. mid-March to mid-October)
- Must live within the District boundaries (approx. north to south, Beezley Hills to Hwy 26; east to west, Soap Lake WA to the Columbia River)

Desired Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

- Ability to prepare plot plans from legal descriptions, survey data, and perform calculations to complete reclassification worksheets required
- Ability to create, interpret, and communicate engineering plans and specifications including open-channel and pipeline hydraulics required
- Ability to generate plans, charts, and graphs using word processing, spreadsheet, and database software required
- Must be able to obtain United States Bureau of Reclamation SCADA clearance
- Self-motivated; able to start and complete projects and tasks with minimal supervision
- Excellent interpersonal and effective communications skills (both oral and written)
- Strong computer skills and working knowledge of Microsoft Office (Word, Excel and Outlook)
