

Irrigation District Manager. The South Columbia Basin Irrigation District (SCBID), one of three districts operating the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation's Columbia Basin Project, is seeking a Secretary/Manager. The Secretary/Manager reports to a five-member board and is responsible for implementing the board's policies and directives.

SCBID serves 230,000 acres of irrigable land in Southeastern Washington and has 115 full-time employees.

A qualified applicant will have a combination of education and experience that includes a bachelor's degree or post graduate degree in agricultural, civil, or irrigation engineering or a related discipline of engineering, business administration, public administration, physical sciences, or similar disciplines. Desired experience includes progressively responsible assignments in irrigation districts or similar water resources organizations, public works municipalities or agencies, or other similar public sector or private sector organizations. Successful experience in leading and managing human resources and interacting with various departments is required. Must be proficient in public relations.

Job location is Pasco, Washington, and duties are districtwide. Frequent daily travel and occasional overnight travel are required. Occasional attendance at evening and weekend meetings is required. The incumbent must reside within the Tri-Cities or within SCBID's service area.

Salary range is expected to be \$110,000.00 to \$135,000.00, depending on qualifications and experience, plus comprehensive benefits.
